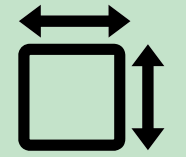
- A record-breaking number of girls earning the Girl Scout Gold Award;

Girl Scouts teamed up with Southwest Airlines and MANA de San Diego to host Operation Wing Scout. 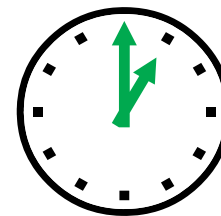

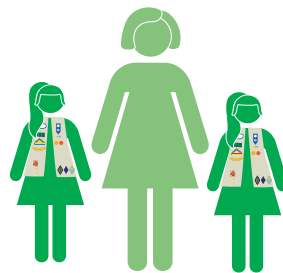

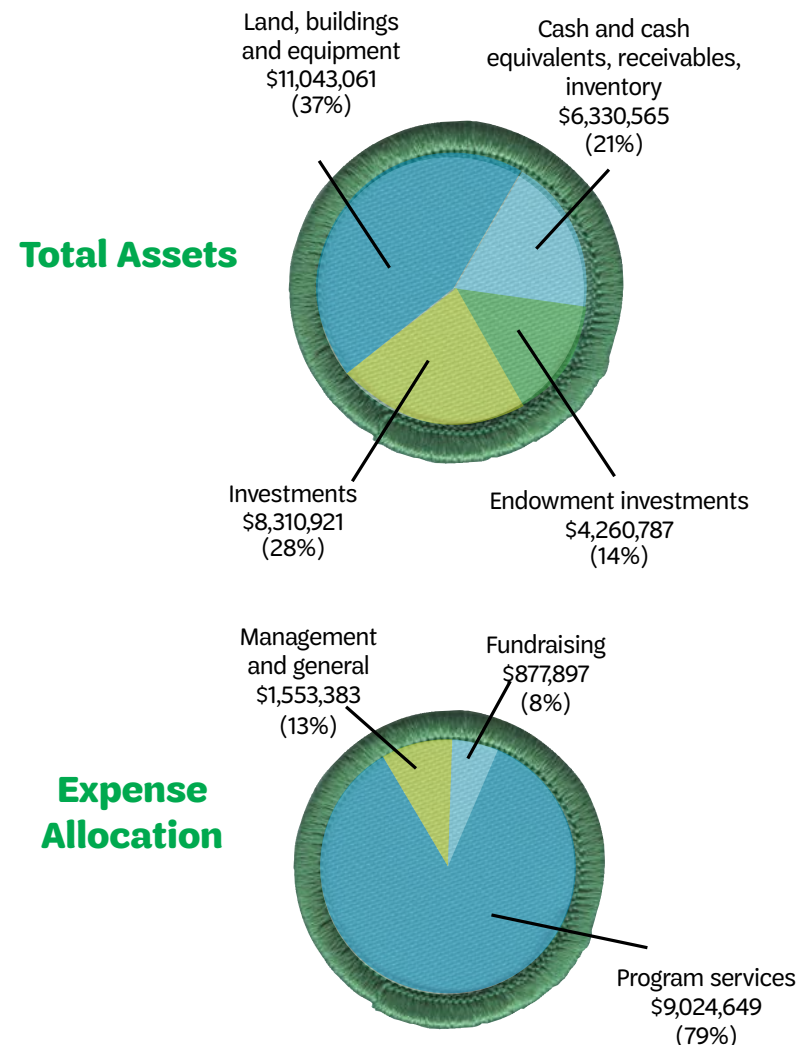
