- We should be using materials other than plastic whenever possible
- If you have to use plastic materials, recycle them when you're done or dispose of them properly
- Don't litter in the ocean (or anywhere else!)

Then we did an awesome recycling activity. The girls learned what various materials are recycled into. For instance, did you know that glass is turned into insulation, that plastic water bottles are made into sleeping bags, and newspapers are turned into kitty litter?

Last, we made a beautiful craft out of recycled materials. Ms. Sunny showed us how to turn recycled jar lids and recycled paper into sun catchers. The girls really enjoyed it.

Here are some talking points from today's meeting:

- Today we read a story about a shark who got caught in a plastic ring. What is one thing we humans can do to prevent this from happening again?
- We learned that many materials can be recycled into new and interesting things. What is one surprising item that is made from recycled materials?
- Today's craft was made with recycled materials. What interesting substance did we rub on the paper to make it translucent?
