Tips to find Cookie Rookies

- Post a message on your service unit Shutterfly page, Facebook group or through their email system, letting new leaders know your experienced Cookie Captains are available to help them have a successful first cookie program.
- Attend a service unit meeting and announce you have Cookie Captains looking for Rookies.
- Connect with your Service Unit Registrar to find beginning troops in your service unit. Email or call the leaders and explain how your Captains can help make their first cookie program easier and more fun.
- Contact your service unit to find out if they are hosting a Service Unit Cookie Kickoff (CKO). Reach out to the event director to find out how Cookie Captains can help.
- Volunteer to run the Service Unit CKO.

If there are few, or no new, Daisy or Brownie troops in your service unit and your Service Unit is not hosting a Cookie Kickoff, email cookies@sdgirlscouts.org by the second Friday in December to request help finding an ENGAGE! opportunity.

Please include the following information – number of captains, program grade level, troop number and service unit, how far you are willing to travel, if you are willing to volunteer at a neighboring Service Unit Cookie Kickoff and any special needs/considerations/limitations.

While the best effort will be made to match every interested Cookie Captain with Cookie Rookies, opportunities are limited and placement cannot be guaranteed.
