



Appreciation Pin overview

The Appreciation Pin recognizes adults who have delivered outstanding service to one or more service unit areas.

Candidate criteria:

- Registered Girl Scout adult member in good standing.
- The candidate has provided outstanding service to a service unit area or program delivery audience in a way that furthers the council's overall mission and goals to serve all girls and increase diversity, membership, and visibility and/or program participation.
- The candidate's service goes above and beyond the expectations for the position that they hold.

Nomination process:

- Submit the Appreciation Pin nomination with two endorsements to Girl Scouts San Diego.
- Endorsements must be from two individuals or groups (other than the nominator), who are familiar with the service performed by the candidate.
- Nomination will be given to the recognitions task group for review.

Approval:

The recognitions task group reviews the nomination form and endorsements and approves or denies the award. The volunteer services team notifies the nominators of acceptance or denial, and notifies candidates of acceptance.

Deadline:	April 30 by 4:30 p.m.
Award presentation:	Annually at the Volunteer Conference and Celebration
